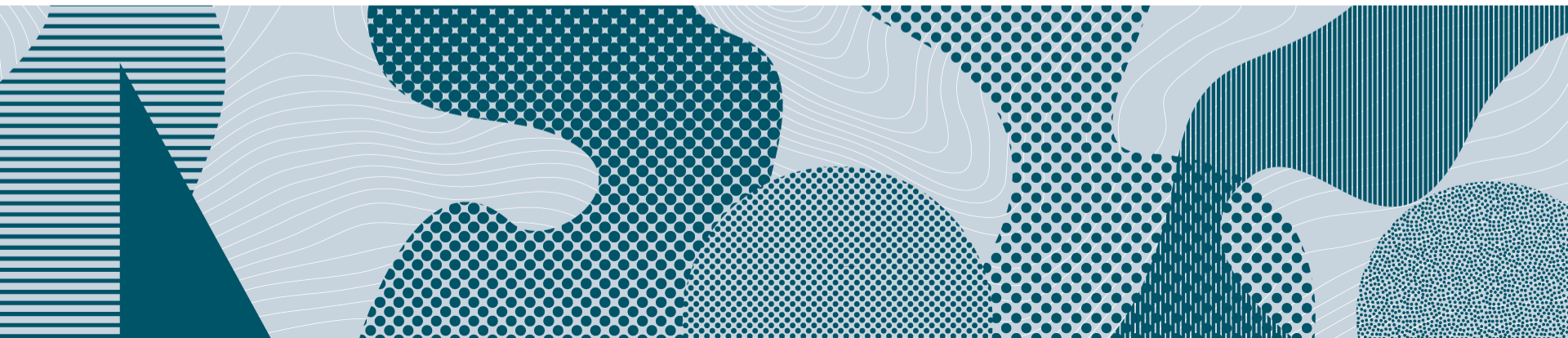

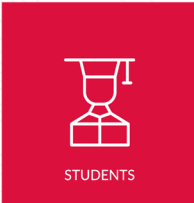

THE **ULAM** NAWA
PROGRAMME

- **Eligible applicant:** at least a doctoral degree, 3 scientific achievements in recent years, representing any field of science, a citizen of any country
- **Project duration:** scientific visits from 6 to 24 months
- **Host:** all universities, scientific institutes of the Polish Academy of Sciences and research institutes. The scientists apply individually after arranging their visits with the host institutions.

Stanisław Marcin Ulam
(1909 -1984)

- Polish mathematician
- member of the internationally renowned Lviv School of Mathematics
- co-author of the Scottish Book
- Before WWII he went to the USA to join the Institute for Advanced Study in Princeton
- associate professor i.a. at the University of Wisconsin, University of Colorado Boulder, Florida State University

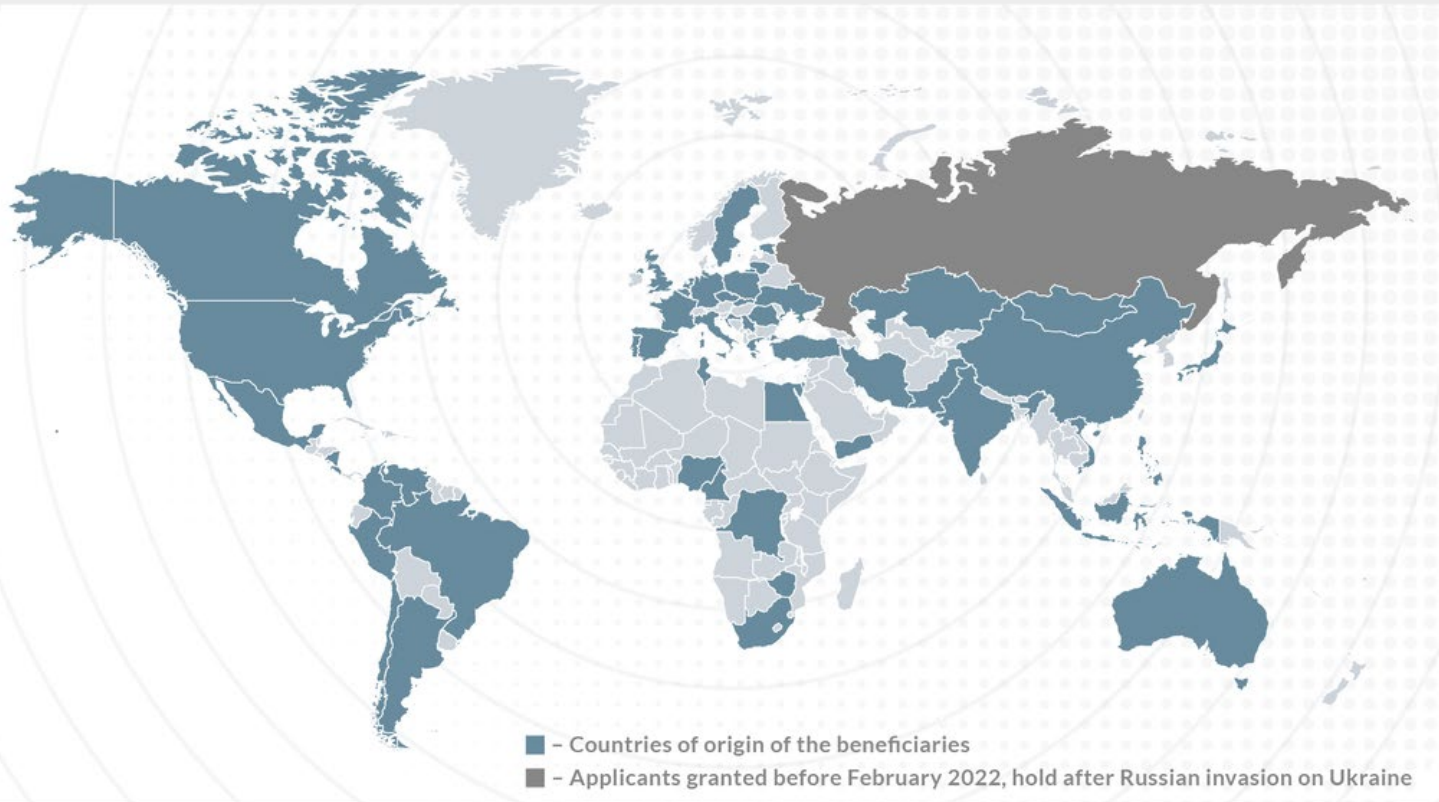


Ulam NAWA - financing

- Scholarship and a living allowance: PLN 11 000 (~ 2 670 EUR) per month
- Allowance for travel depending on the country: PLN 1500 (~ 350 EUR) from Germany
- Monthly support for accompanying children: PLN 2 000 (~ 470 EUR)
- Monthly support if a Fellow has a certificate of severe or moderate disability: PLN 2 000 (~ 470 EUR)

A scholarship, not an employment. Money for research not included.

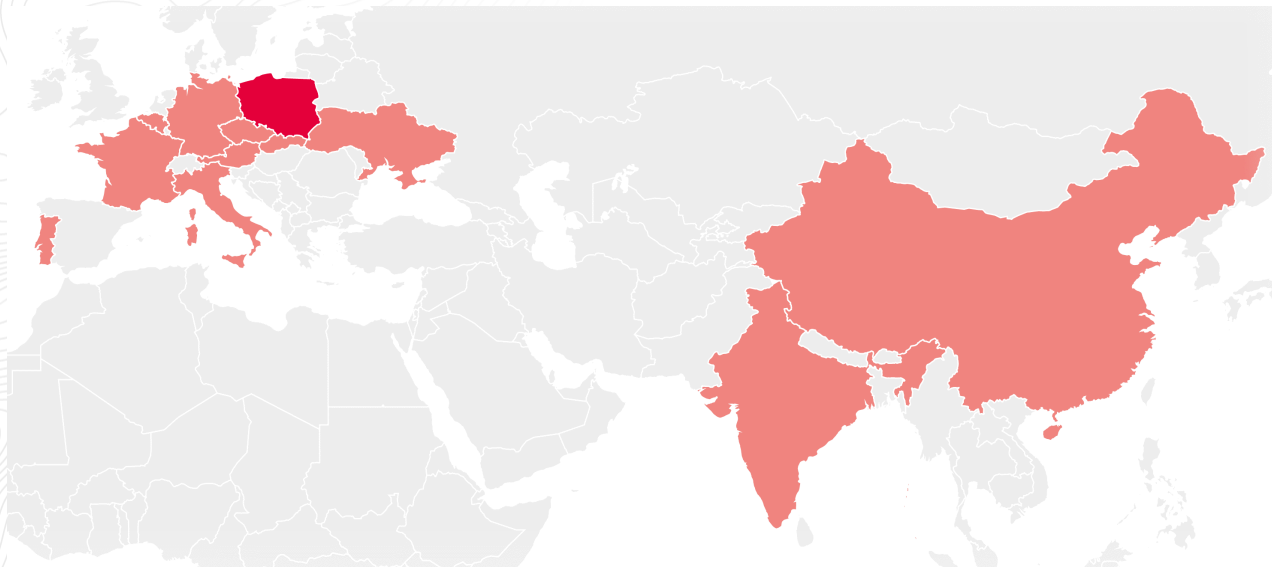

Joint research projects

- Call for applications launched every spring in both DAAD and NAWA
- German partners apply to DAAD, Polish partners apply to NAWA
- Results announced at the end of the year
- Financing from NAWA for travel and costs of stay: max. PLN 30 000 (~ 7 000 EUR) for Polish partners

NAWA will verify the submitted applications and will invite applicants to register in the Agency's ICT System in May 2024.



Zawacka NAWA Programme



German candidates - scholarships are paid by the Polish party
The limit of 200 scholarship months to be distributed for:

- semester stays for students;
- research stays for PhD candidates, scientists and academic teachers (lasting from 1 to 9 months)
- 2023/2024 academic year: 9 applicants from German universities were awarded scholarships (incl. 2 PhD students and 5 scientists).

Polonista NAWA



- For foreign students, PhD students and scientists (also with double citizenship) whose subject of study or research is the Polish language, Polish culture, art, literature or history
- Projects implemented in Polish or English
- 3 to 12 months for researchers
- Partial or full-time studies for students
- 198 fellows (incl. 34 scientists) from 22 countries
- 13 host institutions in PL
- Deadline for applications: **26 April 2024!**

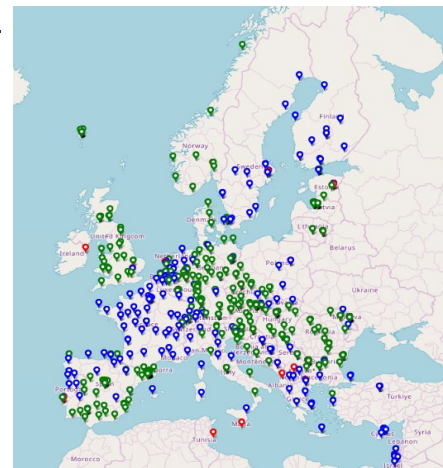

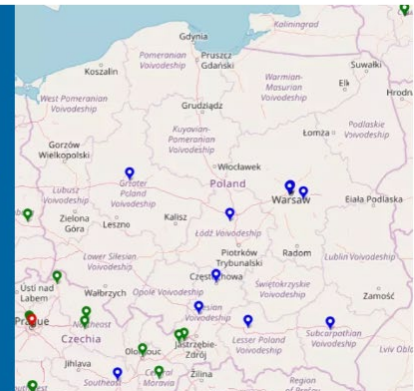

BEKKER NAWA
PROGRAMME

Mieczysław Bekker
(1905-1989)

- Polish engineer and scientist
- Founder of the new scientific specialisation of terramechanics
- Constructed Lunar Roving Vehicle used during the Apollo lunar flights
- 1956 emigrated to the USA
- professor at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor,
- director of the Research Institute of the GM automobile company
- He taught at American technical universities, incl. MIT
- his name was placed in the Space Walk of Fame
